Investigative Services Agencies, Inc., (ISA) Announces \$20,000.00 Reward Countdown for Missing Child Rachel Marie Mellon Skemp *Important: \$20,000.00 Reward Expires at Midnight on July 9, 2010*

Regarding the \$30,000.00 Reward that ISA offered on August 17, 2006 for information leading directly to the whereabouts and recovery of Rachel Marie Mellon Skemp, or for information leading directly to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for her disappearance, ISA announces that the reward offer is being reduced to \$20,000.00 with an expiration date for the award of approximately 20 days from the date of this release.

Specifically, the \$20,000.00 reward offered by ISA will expire at midnight on July 9, 2010.

“Four years have passed since the reward was first offered and we are still waiting for the specific tip needed to solve Rachel’s case. Hopefully, someone out there who has the information we need will be prompted to come forward before the reward expires,” said ISA President James Miller.

Rachel has been missing since January 31, 1996, from Bolingbrook, Illinois. She was 13 years old at that time. On a bitterly cold day with temperatures well below zero, Rachel disappeared from her home without her purse, shoes, coat, and any winter clothing. "I'm hoping this reward countdown will bring in the information needed to solve Rachel's disappearance quickly," said ISA's President Jim Miller.

Rachel's father Jeff Skemp is grateful to ISA for providing this reward over the past four years. "Hopefully, this reward reduction/countdown will bring out the information necessary to put an end to this nightmare we have all endured." Skemp said. "I have always known that someone out there knows something and hopefully this will convince that someone to come forward before the reward expires completely."
